Important safety instructions:



Safety is the first priority.



Smoking and the use of open flame devices are strictly prohibited in/around the plant including all outdoor areas. Smoking is allowed only in designated areas



Hearing protection to be worn in indicated areas. You will find earplug dispensers at the entrance area and at the access area to the paper machine.



Safety shoes must be worn while working in the production hall, the workshop and the warehouses area.



Bump caps are mandatory in the paper machine area.



Safety vests are mandatory in the whole outdoor area.



Keep hands away from running machines. Keep a safe distance.



Risk of slipping and tripping. Pay attention to wet floor and tripping points.



On site the speed limit is 10 km/h., Turn off the engine when you stop.



Fork lifts keep crossing, they have priority.



Written permission is required for work involving fire hazard. Caution during crane operation.



Please note ex-proof-actions in indicated areas.



Alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited.



Filming and photography are strictly prohibited.



Be aware of barriers and guardrails. Use handrails on stairs and stairways.
